

## April 2023 Take It & Make It Mr. Cottontail



Materials List: Wooden Bunny, jute (2 pieces), foam brush, 2 napkins, mod podge, craft or tacky glue to attach the tail



1. Begin by separating the top lay of the napkin and discarding the bottom two layers



2. Spread a thin layer of mod podge onto the bunny and lay the napkin on the mod podge working slowly and smoothing out any creases with your fingers. Be careful not to tear your napkin. Once dry, apply mod podge to the napkin being sure to cover completely and again, smooth out with your fingers as you go. Let dry completely then repeat a second layer.



3. Let dry completely and using scissors or an exacto knife, trim off excess napkin. Turn the bunny over and repeat steps 2 & 3.





4. Take the longer piece of jute and wrap it around your three fingers in a loop until used.



5. Using the shorter piece of jute, tie an knot securing the loops in place.



6. Carefully cut through the top loop and begin to separate the strands and "fluff up" your tail.





7. Glue your tail into place and let dry.
